STATE OF ALABAMA ADOPT-A-MILE PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Alahama Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the "Department," and _______, and other participating crgan: zations hereinafter called the "Group," recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free highways and are entering this Memorandum of Terms and Concitions to permit the Group to contribute toward the effort of maintaining litter-free highways.

Ey execution below, the Group acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and agrees to the following terms and conditions:

- Participants in the Group agree to obey and abide by all laws and regulations relating to safety, and such terms and conditions as may be required by the District Engineer for special conditions which may pertain to a particular adopted section.
- When participants are 15 years of age or younger, the Group shall furnish adequate supervision by one or more adults.
- Individual participants must attend a safety meeting and must execute a release form before participating in a cleanup.
- * Groups may adopt a section of roadway that is one or more miles long.
- * Groups shall be required to adopt for a two-year period.
- * The Group agrees to pick up litter at intervals necessary to keep their adopted mile(s) essentially litter free.
- The Group shall obtain required supplies and materials from the Department during regular business hours.
- Traffic control signs shall be installed by the Group during a cleanup.
- * Individual participants shall wear reflective safety vests during the trash pickup.
- * The Group may leave filled trash bags at the acopted site for pickup and disposal by the Department.
- * Unused materials and supplies and all portable signs, vests, and other equipment furnished by the Department shall be returned to the Department at the termination of the program.

The Department will accomplish the following:

- * Furnish and erect a standard Adopt-A-Mile recognition sign at each end of the adopted section with the appropriate name or acronym of the participating organization displayed.
- Provide warning signs and release forms for participating individuals within the Group.

If in the sole judgement of the Department, it is found that the adopting Group is not meeting the terms and conditions of this agreement, upon 30 days notice the Department may terminate the adoption agreement and remove the signs. The Department reserves the right to modify or cancel the Program at any time.
